

SABA 2020 COVID-19 Start Up Plan

- No Smoking, Vaping or Chewing Tobacco
- No sunflower seeds, gum chewing, spitting
- Sheds only to be entered by Designated coach/parent from each team or SABA Board member
- Chalk boxes, rakes, golf cart/Sand Pro to only be used by Designated coach/parent from each team or SABA Board Member
 - o All equipment to be wiped down after use
- Dugouts and Equipment to be cleaned after each game/practice
- All cleaning materials to be safely stored in equipment sheds
- No Team Water Coolers
 - o All players should provide their own drink with their name on it
- Each team to have their own baseballs to be used when they are playing defense
- Recommended No Equipment Sharing
- 1 head coach, 2 assistant coaches per team
- Every effort will be made to have the same warmup partners for games and practices
- Assigned seats to be used where the players can be 6 feet apart
- Always adhere to 6 feet social distancing when not in game play
- No catchers for T Ball and Farm League
- Umpires to stand behind pitcher's mound
- Coaches wear face masks for mound visits for pitchers
- No High Fives "Tip of the cap rule in effect"
- Players not to arrive at the field before 5:30pm
- No Concession Stand
 - o Emergency drinks or snacks will be available from League Official
- No Bleachers
- Spectators to provide their own chair and adhere to 6 feet, social distancing guideline
- Porta Johns will be sanitized each day
- No Playgrounds until authorized by Jefferson Township
- Players/coaches and spectators must go to their family's car for weather delays

- Players and coach's temperature to be taken upon arrival to the field at designated areas
 - Temperature of 100.4 or above will require player or coach to not attend game of practice. In the event of a fever, families will be asked to monitor for symptoms. If none arise, player may return for next practice/game.
 - Players/Coaches will be given a sticker to show their coach that they have been cleared
- As is recommended by the PA Department of Health and the CDC, SABA encourages all
 players, volunteers and spectators to wear masks when not actively on the field of play.
 It is also recommended that families leave the park as promptly as possible at the end of
 games and practices.
